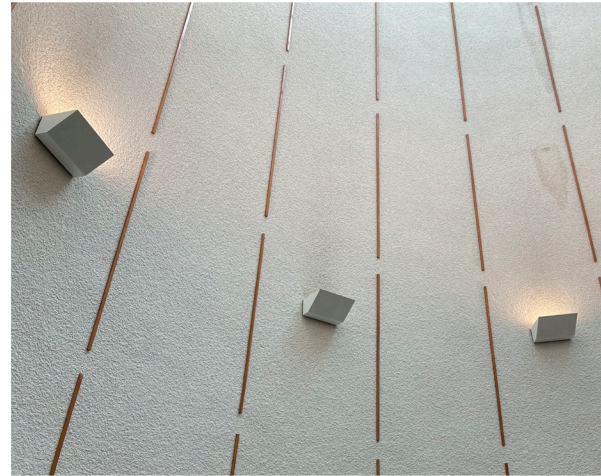




2023 Lighting Upgrade Projects

During 2023, the City of Saint Paul completed building-wide lighting upgrades at 8 community/recreation centers. More than 1900 light fixtures and bulbs were replaced with energy-efficient LED options at these Parks & Recreation Department facilities:



By-the-Numbers

In addition to improving the safety, security, and aesthetics of the buildings these projects will:

335,500 kWh

Reduce total electric use by 335,500 kWh annually

\$35,000

Save approximately \$35,000 in energy costs per year

532,000 pounds

Decrease emissions from city building operations by 532,000 lbs. of CO₂ annually

4.4 years

Achieve an average project payback of only 4.4 years



LED lighting retrofits throughout the **Dayton's Bluff Recreation Center** will decrease the building's annual electric use by 58,000 kWh and save over **\$8000 per year** on utility costs.
